1.	One of the likely supplier stated that the Supply time between receiving of NOA and supply to NACO will take minimum of 120 days. This is owing to the fact that Raltegravir-400 mg Tablet is imported brand. Hence the time to make available the product in India for supply looking into necessary government regulation and processes to be considered. Artwork (approved) which is in current circulation is requested to be approved from NACO since any change in artwork will take minimum of 6 months of approval period from DCGI, which may further delay the delivery period. 2.	Darunavir 600 mg and Ritonovir 100 mg is now available as Fixed dose combination of single tablet.
